Best Practices for Online Learning



Connect with your teacher: Use the canvas inbox to message your teacher and check your messages often.



Log In Everyday Monday Through Friday: This is a good habit to have. Online courses are paced for success.



Do The Work: This seems obvious, but one mistake some online students make is not to watch/listen to online media that has been assigned.



Ask For Help: Just like in a face to face classroom, if you need help, ask for it. Utilize direct messages to the teacher, or online peer discussion boards if they are available.



Read/ Subscribe to class announcements: Announcements are often utilized, much like a classroom Whiteboard. Teachers may post information that is important to the class in this area



Stay Organized: Just like face to face classes, you generate a lot of material in an online class. Be intentional about file organization.



Find a Workspace: Find a place to work that is comfortable and free from distractions
